

## RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF SIGNATORIES TO TE TIRITI O WAITANGI

Articles	Hapū ↓ Māori	Crown → NZ Government ↓ Tangata Tiriti
Article One: <i>kawanatanga</i>	Responsibility: To respect the right of the government to govern	<b>Right: to govern</b>
Article Two: <i>tino rangatiratanga</i>  <i>land sales</i>	<b>Right: to retain control of all they value</b>  <b>Right: all land sales voluntary</b> Responsibility: for land sales to be managed by the government	Responsibility: To ensure hapu retain control of all they value  Responsibility: Ensure land sales are voluntary <b>Right: to manage land sales</b>
Article Three: <i>Maori rights</i>	<b>Right: have same rights and protections as British people</b>	Responsibility: ensure Maori have the same rights and protections as British people
Article Four: <i>protection of Maori customs</i>	<b>Right: to have customs protected</b>	<b>Responsibility: to ensure Maori customs protected</b>

Note: The Articles of the Treaty specifically state rights conferred on each party (see bold). The (implied) corresponding responsibilities for both parties have been added.
