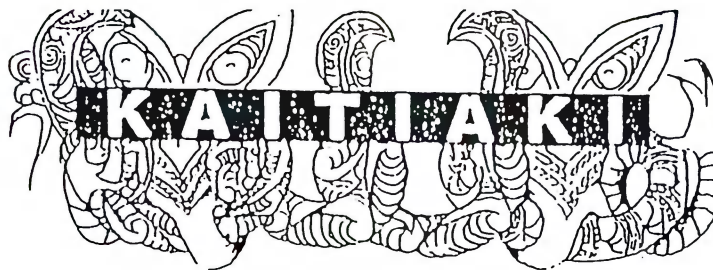

Tena Koutou Katoa,

This year Aotearoa is recognising 150 years of colonialism, for some people it is regarded as progress, for others however, it is quite the opposite.
