## EDITORIAL

A diagram and discussion session held during the Whanganui gathering has created a bubbling-up of reaction, dialogue, toing-and froing, editorials, anxiety, concern and questioning among Treaty workers. The basis of the workshop was the old dilemma, *who should we/our organisation/the organisation we are doing Treaty work with-be recognising as "nga rangatira" and "nga hapu" and "nga tangata katoa o Nu Tirenī" (as in Te Tiriti o Waitangi), and is this the same as "nga tinorangatira o te iwi o Nu Tirenī", (as in He Wakaputanga o te Rangatira o Nu Tirenī.)*

Every year a new challenge confronts us at the national gathering, every year we need to ask ourselves old questions in new ways.

Perhaps it is time to remind ourselves of the learnings from Moana Jackson's feedback last year, his concerns about our aim to 'actively support te tino rangatiratanga'. This challenge helped clarify our role then, and is a strong basis for our discussions now. A thought then, was for us to be analysing and working on *how pakeha/non-Maori structures effect the Treaty*. This analysis would then give us clear directions to the obstacles and oppressive practices that need to be dismantled. Control of structures and processes by non-Maori is the problem.

The drawing of a diagram by pakeha, of Maori structures which have emerged because of the effect of pakeha structures on and control of the Treaty, and the renaming of these structures by pakeha as 'Bubbles', has immense power. For us to suggest that these 'Bubbles' are now redundant, or get in the way, causes some concern. The effect on people and groups 'new' to Treaty work bore this out.

As Treaty workers with a fair amount of power, we need to be very careful that we, in our earnestness and maybe our quest to get it politically squeaky-clean correct, *do not ourselves take control of the Rangatiratanga structure, definition or name.*

Last year we cautioned ourselves not to coopt words and phrases such as *tino rangatiratanga* and *mana whenua*. These are not our words nor our concepts. In trying to define them and the people who belong to them, we may well repeat the very processes that we are trying to stop.

Lets keep the dialogue going, keep looking for the language which describes us, our work and our place in the environment of our time,

MINUTES - NETWORK WAITANGI AGM  
BUSHY PARK KAIKIWI  
September 18 1993

1) Minutes of 1992 AGM presented.

Matters arising : Reprint of Network Waitangi booklet  
Treaty of Waitangi - Questions and Answers

500 copies of the revised booklet are currently being prepared.  
Cost approx - \$1600.

The aims of Network Waitangi as stated in the Constitution need to be revised. Meeting moves that this be discussed in relation to Charitable Trust status.

Catherine Peet moved that the minutes be accepted as read. Marlene Benson seconded. Accepted unanimously.

2) Report from Coordinator, Karena Way.

a) Karena outlined the difficulties the coordinating group had encountered in transferring funds from Napier. These were not secured until June, however some monies remain in an account there, which are received from automatic payments. This will be remedied.

The financial statement was presented. The accounts have only recently been audited, and will need to be sent to the registrar for Incorporated Societies.

b) Precis of tasks Coordinating Group will take on.

\* Produce a newssheet and Action Alerts. The newssheet will depend on regional groups providing information of events, workshops, actions etc they are undertaking. A fax network will be established to facilitate urgent response to Action Alerts. The Coordinating Group will act as a nerve centre for sending out material it receives.

\* Coordinate training for trainers as requested. Produce a Code of Ethics for Treaty & Anti-Racism. Educators. This will incorporate valuable work already done in this area.

\* Provide telephone support and back up media statements made by regional groups. The Coordinating Group will not be taking on a national media profile.

\* Farm out work to regional NW groups when approached by organisations wanting workshops organised on a national basis.

\* Be a resource centre for publications, newsclippings etc we receive and distribute to groups.

3) Kathy Pelly Trust

Andrew moved that the grant from the Kathy Pelly Trust be returned. Marlene seconded. Passed.

#### 4) Charitable Trust Status

NW Otautahi reported back on investigations it had conducted into the possibility of gaining Charitable Trust Status. The aims of Network Waitangi would need to be more specific to qualify, with the best lever being promotion of NW as an organisation involved in the advancement of education. While Otautahi felt it important to reclaim the status of charitable work as a tool for social change, the meeting felt that it could compromise NW's autonomy and political activities were it to apply for status. Also groups questioned the amount of energy that would be required pursuing the matter with government authorities. It was resolved to put the issue on the back burner.

#### 5) Membership of Network Waitangi

It was clarified that membership of NW is based upon subscribing to the aims of the organisation as laid down in the Constitution and contributing an annual fee of \$20 per group and \$10 per individual. This can be paid by installments.

It was requested that all NW regional groups network with people in their region and ask that they forward their names and membership fee to the coordinating group if they wish to be included on a list of NW members.

#### 6) Support of Maori Treaty Educators

The meeting resolved that they will not conduct workshops for organisations unless the latter commit to providing separate training for Maori staff run by Maori educators. NW groups will assist in providing contacts.

7) Karena moved that an equivalent amount of funding to that spent on financing this AGM be accessed from NW finances to NW Wanganui to resource a local Maori initiative. Dianne seconded. Passed.

The Coordinating group thanked NW Wanganui for the effort they had put into organising the AGM. Wanganui asked that a card be sent to Karen Kendrick in recognition for her work as former NW coordinator.

## ***Nga Kaiwhakapumau i Te Reo & N.Z.Maori Council Appeal to the Privy Council.***

On November 1st 1993,an appeal of major significance for the mana and survival of Te Reo Maori will be heard by the Privy Council in London.

Brought jointly by Nga Kaiwhakapumau (The Preservers of the Language) headed by Huirangi Waikerepuru ,and the N.Z.Maori Council ,the appeal is aimed at securing a deal that guarantees the Maori language a substantial and regular place on mainstream television, from the N.Z.Government.

These two groups have a combined 13 year history of fighting for the language.In 1986 Nga Kaiwhakapumau brought an extensive claim before the Waitangi Tribunal which led to Maori being granted the status of an official language,and to the creation of the Maori Language Commission.They were involved from 1983 to 1986 in a one-week-per-year Maori Language Radio Station,which led to Te Reo Iirangi o Te Upoko o te Ika in 1987.

Both groups were involved in the Aotearoa Broadcasting Systems application for the 3rd TV channel.

In 1990 the groups lodged a claim with the Waitangi Tribunal opposing the privatisation and selling of broadcasting frequencies.A High Court injunction and appeal court decision were also needed and eventually forced the Government to reserve a range of frequencies for Iwi stations.

With the transformation of state broadcasting corporations into SOE's Nga Kaiwhakapumau and the Council feared that Maori language would lose out in a market-driven,ratings-oriented environment.They applied for an interim injunction preventing the transfer of assets on the grounds that Maori language wasn't adequately protected in the new system.and therefore the crōwn was acting in breach of the Treaty.

Justice McGechan decided the Crown was doing enough for Maori radio, but plans for television were inadequate. He prepared to lift the injunction when the Government promised to spend an extra \$13 million on Maori broadcasting over the next three years. The Maori parties went to the Court of Appeal, because the mere spending of money wouldn't guarantee that Maori language programs would actually be broadcast - in the free-market environment a Ministerial Directive or Contract was needed to ensure that SOE's actively protect the language.

### **OCCUPATION OF TIEKE HUT AND SURROUNDING LAND BY TE WHANUA O TIEKE.**

Tieke, 267 acres, is situated by the Whanganui River, nearly 20 miles upstream from Pipiriki. The land and hut are part of the Whanganui River National Park, currently controlled by the Department of Conservation, but under claim to the Waitangi Tribunal as part of the enormous Waimarino Claim-(Wai 221)-which involves nearly 400,000 acres and was lodged 30 months ago.

Incensed by both the desecration of the old urupa which has occurred over the years and D.O.C.'s plans to introduce additional user charges *to fund improvements which would make the claim less likely to succeed*, the iwi reclaimed the site on the 15th of September.

Since then a steady occupation has been kept up with numbers averaging 25 during the week and swelling to over 100 at weekends. Access is by jet boat and canoe. Normal use of the river has continued and all groups calling at Tieke have reported a warm reception and an enlightening experience.

All four Appeal Court judges agreed that the restructuring was carried out in breach of the Treaty, and that the Crown may no longer be able to protect Maori language. Three turned down the appeal on the grounds that the new system was already in place, and transferring the assets wouldn't make matters any worse. The fourth judge, Appeal Court President Sir Robin Cooke, upheld the appeal. He said the transfer would limit the Crown's capacity to comply with Treaty principles, and once the lever of assets was lost, Maori would be unlikely to get satisfaction from consultations with the Crown.

This strong support for the plaintiff's by Sir Robin gives us hope for a favourable result when the Privy Council reviews the split decision of the Court of Appeal on November 1st.

These cases have borne much fruit already, including the \$40 million which has gone to Maori radio since 1989, and the establishment of Te Reo Whakapuaki Irirangi.

This ACTION ALERT is a request that you consider supporting Nga Kaiwhakapuamau and the Council in their important task in taking the Appeal to London.

Dear Mrs Shipley,

Network Waitangi Whangarei is a group of Pakeha people working toward a society based on the Treaty of Waitangi.

We were alarmed to read of the threat to the kohanga reo movement of the cut in childcare subsidy hours from 30 to nine a week for parents not in work, education or training.

About 90% of parents with children in Whangarei's 22 kohanga reo are on a benefit or a very low income. We believe the subsidy allows these parents to send their children to kohanga reo. Without it, we believe there is a real possibility that one of New Zealand's two official languages will die.


The signing of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child by your government recognises and confirms some of the basic tenets of the Treaty of Waitangi. These include the rights of indigenous cultures to enjoy and practise their own beliefs and language.

Article 29 of the Convention requires public education to foster respect for parents and for the values of their culture. Article 30 respects the rights of minority groups to convey their particular ethos to their children.

The ratification of the Convention requires governments to enable indigenous people real access to education in their own language. The cutting of the subsidies is in direct contrast to this aim.

The subsidy cuts threatens the survival of our dual cultural heritage. We ask you to reconsider this policy urgently.

Dear Mr Bolger,

We understand that the US government has proposed at the GATT talks on Trade Related Intellectual Property (TRIPS) that governments agree to the patenting of all life forms, and that at meetings next week our government is entering into negotiations at an international level for the commercial exploitation of rights belonging to the people of Aotearoa.

Indigenous flora and fauna must remain the responsibility of the Indigenous people who are the kaitiaki (caretakers) for future generations.

We understand there is a claim before the Waitangi Tribunal brought by Haana Murray, Dell Wihongi and others which asserts the ultimate authority of te Tino rangatiratanga in the text of Te Tiriti O Waitangi and thus to seek a recognition of the sovereign right of Maori to make resource decisions. The claim states that acts and omissions by the Crown in relation to native flora and fauna are a denial of tino rangatiratanga and contrary to Te Tiriti O Waitangi.

Until this case has been heard the Government does not have the right to sign any agreement that takes away the rights that Maori understand are theirs.

Also at the First International Conference on the Cultural and Intellectual Property Rights of Indigenous Peoples held at Whakatane 12-18 June 1993, The Mataatua Declaration was formulated, and states in the section on Biodiversity and Customary Environmental Management that-"Indigenous flora and faunas inextricably bound to the territories of indigenous communities and any property rights claims must recognise their traditional guardianship.

Also-"Commercialisation of any traditional plants and medicines of Indigenous Peoples must be managed by the indigenous peoples who have inherited the knowledge."

We strongly urge you and your government to give very serious consideration to this issue and not sign any agreement that takes away the rights that Maori understand are theirs.
